## Summer Art Enrichment Programs

ArtFusion's free out-of-school-time programs are funded by The Greater Pottstown Foundation.

- All classes are held at 254 E. High St. in downtown Pottstown. **TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED.**
- While the program is free, each participant is required to pay a \$15 registration fee, which also entitles them to an ArtFusion kids membership. Memberships provide discounts on classes and parties for one year. The registration fee is due when you are notified that you were accepted into the program and is non-refundable.
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis. There are a limited number of spaces available. All applications must be received by June 6, 2015.
- While preference will be given to students who qualify for free or reduced lunch, all students are encouraged to apply. Students who have already attended an Academy class before may apply, but preference will be given to those students who are new to the program.
- If after determining who is new to the program and who applied first, there are still more applicants than available spaces, the short paragraphs written by the student and by the parent will be used to determine who will be accepted into the program.
- You will be notified if you have been accepted into this program. **If you provide an email address, we will use that address to contact you about your application.** Please be sure to check your account regularly.
- Applicants must completely fill out the attached application form. *We require a separate application form for each student who is applying.* **Every applicant must write about why they want to participate in this program. The applicant's parent or guardian is also required to write why they think their child should be considered for this program.**
- **It is very important that the student write their section themselves.** If an application is missing a student paragraph, or if a parent writes that section for their child, the application will not be accepted.
- Attendance in this program is very important. Students cannot miss more than two days of class or they will be dropped from the program. Students who are dropped will not be eligible to participate in any free programs at ArtFusion for one calendar year.
- Students may not apply for and attend more than one free program during a session. (For example: if a student applies for Clay Academy, they are not eligible to attend Kids Art Academy.) Please check the appropriate box on the application indicating the program you are applying for.
- Completed applications must be returned to ArtFusion. Please do not send them to your child's school. Applications can be dropped off or mailed to the address below:

## 2015 Summer Art Enrichment Program Choices

**PLEASE NOTE:** All free summer programs include a fun off-site class the week of July 4th. We will be visiting the Althouse Arboretum in Upper Pottstgrove. The class will take place on Thursday, July 2 from 11am-2pm. We will enjoy a short talk about the Arboretum, take a nature walk, and work on a fun art project. Students are asked to bring a packed lunch so we can eat at this beautiful site. Parents are welcome to join us for the day, but it is not required. Transportation will be provided.

### **Summer Kids Art Academy (ages 8-12)**

Students will spend 8 weeks learning art history and exploring different mediums and techniques, from drawing, mosaics, painting, and sculpture to mask-making, fiber arts and more. Class begins June 26 and runs Fridays from 1-2:30pm. Maximum 15 students.

### **Clay Academy (ages 8-12)**

Students will spend 8 weeks developing important pottery skills including wedging, using the wheel, hand building and finishing. Class begins June 26 and runs Fridays from 1-2:30pm. Maximum 9 students.

### **It's Elementary! (ages 8-12)**

The written word is such an important way to communicate. A visual piece can also tell a story. This class will help students to create a visual piece of art and also practice the written word. Art and story will run hand and hand. Class begins June 25 and runs Thursdays from 10:30am-noon for 6 weeks. Maximum 15 students.
