Waivers and Safety for Ceramic Arts Education

All students are required to complete and sign a liability waiver, and read and agreed to abide by the safety procedures as outlined by ArtFusion.

Safety in the Pottery Studio:

1. Always follow the instructions of your teacher.
2. Students will not load, unload or operate the pottery kilns.
3. Keep hair tied back.
4. Do not wear articles of clothing or jewelry that hang off the body.
5. Do not wear open toed or open heeled footwear (i.e., flip-flops, sandals or clogs) in the pottery studio.
6. Do not use any equipment without an instructor present.
7. **All completed work must be picked up from ArtFusion no later than 6 weeks after the student's final class. ArtFusion is not responsible for any work left longer than 6 weeks. It is the student's responsibility to pick up their work.**
