2019 Art Enrichment Program for Teens

ArtFusion's free out-of-school-time programs are funded by The Greater Pottstown Foundation.

- All classes are held at our new facility at 341 Beech St. in downtown Pottstown. **TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED.**
- While the program is free, each participant is required to pay a \$15 registration fee, which also entitles them to an ArtFusion teen membership. Memberships provide discounts on classes and parties for one year. **The fee must be paid before the start of class in order to hold your teen's space in the program.**
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis. There are a limited number of spaces available, so we recommend applying early. Each session has a separate application deadline. Please see the individual session descriptions for details. You will be notified whether your teen has been accepted.
- While preference will be given to students who qualify for free or reduced lunch, all students are encouraged to apply. Students who have already attended a free ArtFusion program before may apply, but preference will be given to those students who are new to the program.
- If after determining who is new to the program and who applied first, there are still more applicants than available spaces, the short paragraphs written by the student and by the parent will be used to determine who will be accepted into the program.
- You will be notified if you have been accepted into this program. **If you provide an email address, we will use that address to contact you about your application.** Please be sure to check your account regularly.
- Applicants must completely fill out the attached application form. *We require a separate application form for each student who is applying.* **Every applicant must write about why they want to participate in this program. The applicant's parent or guardian is also required to write why they think their teen should be considered for this program.**
- **It is very important that the student write their section themselves.** If an application is missing a student paragraph, or if a parent writes that section for their student, the application will not be accepted.
- There are seven topic concentrations offered for this program. Student may choose as many as they want to attend. However, attendance in this program is very important. Students cannot miss more than two days of class or they will be dropped from the program, and will not be able to attend any other sessions they have selected. Students who are dropped will not be eligible to participate in any free programs at ArtFusion for one calendar year.

- Completed applications must be returned to ArtFusion. Please do not send them to your teen's school. Applications can be dropped off at our Beech St. location, scanned and emailed to info@artfusion19464.org, or mailed to the address below:

2019 Free Teen Art Enrichment Program Choices

APRIL

Recycled And Upcycled Art with Julie Tonnessen

Students will learn to create with recycled, upcycled and salvaged materials, to learn to see the creative value in items normally discarded. We will also explore the role of art in bringing awareness to environmental issues. Max 5 students. Class begins April 18 and runs Thursdays from 4:30-6pm for 4 weeks. **Application deadline is April 4.**

MAY

Painting with Erika Hornburg

Learn how to translate your vision into your art. In this class, you will explore different painting techniques and mediums. Max 5 students. Class begins May 16 and runs Thursdays from 4:30-6pm for 4 weeks. . **Application deadline is May 2.**

JUNE

Figure Drawing with Kira Popky

Students will learn how to draw the human form using a live, clothed model. Class runs June 26, July 10, July 17 and July 31 from 3-4:30pm each week. Max 5 students. . **Application deadline is June 12.**

JULY

Jewelry with Hali MacLaren

During this metalsmithing course you will learn the proper techniques to drill, pierce, file, sand and polish flat sheet metal. With these skills, you will make your own brass monogrammed necklace, keychain or bookmark! Max 5 students. Class runs from 3:30-5:30pm on July 8, 9, 15 and 16. . **Application deadline is June 24.**

OCTOBER

Fused Glass and Mosaics with Julie Tonnessen

Students will learn to create with glass. We will design several pieces in fused glass that we will then incorporate into a mosaic. Max 5 students. Class begins October 9 and runs Wednesdays from 4:30-6 for 4 weeks. **Application deadline is September 25.**

OCTOBER

Fiber Arts with Julie Tonnessen and Kristen VonHohen

Non-traditional materials can make incredible art. Students will experience sewing, needle felting and basket making. Max 5 students. Class starts October 10 and runs Thursdays from 4:30-6pm for 4 weeks. **Application deadline is September 26.**

NOVEMBER

Pottery with Kristen VonHohen

Students will explore the possibilities of clay through a modular piece: crafting many units to make one finished artwork. We will have 3 weeks to build our piece, and 1 week to glaze. Max 5 students. Class runs Thursdays from 4:30-6pm on November 7, 14 and 21 and December 5. **Application deadline is October 24.**
