



Create with a Cop Culinary Program for Kids

Funded by Pottstown Area Health & Wellness Foundation and Pottstown FARM and run in partnership with ArtFusion 19464 and the Pottstown Police Department.

Create with a Cop is a grass roots community initiative designed to bridge the gap between our youth and community. This program is structure to create a safe haven where youth can develop skills for positive change and hope. We recognize that the “voices” of our youth are assets which help build community, friendships and self-confidence.

Create with a Cop Culinary Program is a 7 week program for children ages 10-12 years, with a special opportunity for student to put their new skills to use in helping to create a community meal in January 9. Students will learn about farming on a small scale, shopping and food costs, learn food safety, create menus, bake, the science behind culinary arts, and bring home a prepared meal. They will learn how to sustain a healthy eating lifestyle in a city like environment, engage with our community police and as a final project in January, they will create a menu, prepare a community meal and help serve it. Class begins September 30, 2019 and runs every Monday from 6:00 to 7:30 for the first 7 weeks. The Community Meal will be held in January where students will receive their certificates, tee-shirts & utensils for culinary success. Maximum 10 students.

- Classes are held at 137 E High St Downtown Pottstown each week from 6-7:30PM. TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED.
- While the program is free, each participant is required to pay a \$25 materials fee, payable to the instructor at Grumpy's. This fee is due when you are notified that you were accepted into the program and is non-refundable. The fee must be paid before the start of class in order to hold your child's space in the program. Registration is on a first come, first served basis, and are decided based on essays and completion of all paperwork. No exceptions are made. There are a limited number of spaces available for this program.
- All applications must be received by September 13, 2019. You will be notified by September 20 if your child has been accepted. All students accepted will be sent an official registration form and waiver that will need to be returned 1 week prior to class start.
- The short essay written by the student AND by the parent will be used to determine who will be accepted into this program. If you provide an email address, we will use that address to contact you about your application. Please be sure to check your account and spam folder regularly. You will be notified by ArtFusion 19464.
- Applicants must completely fill out the attached application form. We require a separate application form for each student who is applying. Every applicant must write (by themselves in their own handwriting) about why they want to participate in this program.





- The applicant's parent or guardian is also required to write why they think their child should be considered for this program. It is very important that the student write their section themselves.
- If an application is missing a student and/or parent essay, the application will not be accepted. Attendance in this program is very important. Students cannot miss class or they may be dropped from the program. Students who are dropped will not be eligible to participate in any future programs for one calendar year. The FARM Director will have the right to excuse or not excuse an absence due to illness or an emergency.
