## 2020 Fall Art Enrichment Program for Teens

*ArtFusion's free out-of-school-time programs are funded by The Greater Pottstown Foundation.*

- Some programs are held in person. Others are done virtually through a live online class. In person classes are held at 341 Beech St in downtown Pottstown. **TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED.**
- While the program is free, each participant is required to pay a \$15 registration fee, which also entitles them to an ArtFusion teen membership. Memberships provide discounts on classes and parties for one year. **The fee must be paid before the start of class in order to hold your teen's space in the program.**
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis. There are a limited number of spaces available, so we recommend applying early. You will be notified whether your teen has been accepted.
- While preference will be given to students who qualify for free or reduced lunch, all students are encouraged to apply. Students who have already attended a free ArtFusion program before may apply, but preference will be given to those students who are new to the program.
- If after determining who is new to the program and who applied first, there are still more applicants than available spaces, the short paragraphs written by the student and by the parent will be used to determine who will be accepted into the program.
- You will be notified if you have been accepted into this program. **If you provide an email address, we will use that address to contact you about your application.** Please be sure to check your account regularly.
- Applicants must completely fill out the attached application form. *We require a separate application form for each student who is applying.* **Every applicant must write about why they want to participate in this program. The applicant's parent or guardian is also required to write why they think their teen should be considered for this program.**
- **It is very important that the student write their section themselves.** If an application is missing a student paragraph, or if a parent writes that section for their student, the application will not be accepted.
- There are several topic concentrations offered for this program. Student may choose as many as they want to attend. However, attendance in this program is very important. Students cannot miss more than two days of class or they will be dropped from the program, and will not be able to attend any other sessions they have selected. Students who are dropped will not be eligible to participate in any free programs at ArtFusion for one calendar year.
- Completed applications must be returned to ArtFusion. Please do not send them to your teen's school. Applications can be dropped off at our Beech St. location, scanned and emailed to [info@artfusion19464.org](mailto:info@artfusion19464.org), or mailed to the address below:

## **Fall 2020 Free Teen Art Enrichment Program Choices**

### **In-Person Jewelry with Hali MacLaren**

Students will learn the basics of working with brass or copper sheet metal and wire, using various traditional jeweler's tools and techniques. Class begins October 1 and runs Thursdays from 3:30-5pm for 4 weeks.

### **In-Person Pottery with Kristen VonHohen**

This class will consist of a series of timed creativity changes. Students will explore how time and craftsmanship intersect and affect your final piece. Students will use hand-building techniques only (no wheel). Class begins November 5 and runs Thursdays from 4-5:30 for 4 weeks. No class 11/26.

### **Hybrid Mosaics with Julie Tonnessen**

This program will consist of a combination of in person classes and online check-ins. Students will learn how to cut and work with glass to design and create a one of a kind mosaic project. We will discuss the history of mosaics and learn how to use color, shape, size and contrast to create a clear mosaic image. All supplies will be provided and students will be allowed to borrow ArtFusion tools to work at home. In person class is Wednesday, October 28 from 3:30-5:30pm. Virtual check in class will run Wednesdays, November 4, 11 and 18 from 3:30-4pm. During check ins, we will share progress on our projects and work cooperatively to decide on next steps. Students will also be able to make in-person appointments for help and to pick up additional materials, if needed.

### **Hybrid Fiber Arts with Julie Tonnessen**

This program will consist of a combination of in person classes and online check-ins. Students will learn how to dye their own yarn using food safe dyes. They will learn how to design, construct and weave a one-of-a-kind piece of fiber art. All supplies will be provided and students will be allowed to borrow ArtFusion tools to work at home. In person class is Tuesday, October 27 from 3:30-5:30pm. Virtual check in class will run Wednesdays, November 4, 11 and 18 from 4:30-5pm. During check ins, we will share progress on our projects and work cooperatively to decide on next steps. Students will also be able to make in-person appointments for help and to pick up additional materials, if needed.

### **Virtual Life Drawing with Kira Phillips**

This class is an intro to figure drawing meant to strengthen drawing techniques while learning basic anatomy. Students will study figures from reference images and learn tips and tricks to drawing body structures and faces. A sketchbook is required (one with rings is suggested but not mandatory) and a favored pencil and eraser. Supplies that are not requirements but are nice to have are: a set of drawing pencils, kneaded erasers, paper blenders or cotton swabs. If you need help with supplies, please let us know. Class begins October 30 and runs Fridays from 4-5:30pm for 4 weeks. All of our virtual classes are run on the Zoom platform. After you register you will be emailed a secure link to join the class. To take full advantage of this online interactive platform, you will need video and audio capabilities, either through a smart phone, computer or tablet.
