- This is an open show. There is a \$15 exhibit fee for ArtFusion Artists to participate in this show. The exhibit fee for those who are not currently ArtFusion Artists is \$25. Please contact us if you are not sure of your status. **Your exhibit fee covers all three pieces you may enter in this show.**
- You may submit a total of 3 pieces for this show. Each piece must relate to the theme of "Paraphrase."
- How to interpret the show's theme:
 - The art in Paraphrase will all be inspired by a favorite quote. The quote can be from a song, a book, a movie, or a person you admire. You do not have to include the actual words of the quote in your art (but of course you can). The quote can be funny, profound, or just remind you of something you love. The artwork can be any size and in any medium.
- Artwork details:
 - All 2D pieces must be framed. If your piece is stretched canvas, it may be unframed as long as all the edges are painted with no staples showing.
 - All 3D work must be free standing.
 - All pieces must be labeled on the back with the artist's name and title of the piece. (No prices, or other contact information please.)
 - Please make sure all framed pieces have **PICTURE WIRE**. Our hanging system does not accept sawtooth hangers.
 - Also check mats for dirt and uneven cuts and frames for dents and chips. Any frame condition issues will be listed on your inventory sheet.
 - ALL PIECES MUST BE FOR SALE.
- All work is sold on a consignment basis. The artist sets the selling price. When a piece sells, ArtFusion retains 35% of the selling price as a commission. For complete details on our sales policy, please request a copy of our consignment contract.
- All participating artists must submit a form W-9 (federal form) and sign our consignment contract. This paperwork will be sent to you upon acceptance into this show.
- If you cannot pick up or drop off on the date indicated, please call to make arrangements BEFORE that date.
- Registrations must be received by August 19, 2022. Artists will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. If the show reaches capacity before the registration date, we
