Summer 2022 Free Art Programs for Kids

These free programs are funded by The Greater Pottstown Foundation.

Applications due by May 31, 2022.

In Person Art Academy (ages 8-12)

Students will spend 8 weeks exploring different mediums and techniques. They will create both 2D and 3D projects, and be inspired by artists from all over the world. Class begins June 21 and runs Tuesdays from 1-2:30pm for 8 weeks. NO CLASS JULY 5. Maximum 10 students.

In Person Clay Academy (ages 8-12)

Students will spend 8 weeks developing important pottery skills including wedging, hand building and finishing. Class begins June 24 and runs Fridays from 10:30am-noon for 8 weeks. NO CLASS JULY 8. Maximum 9 students.

In-Person Fiber Academy (ages 8-12)

Get ready to for an incredible journey through the wonderful world of fiber arts! From hand sewing to knitting to embroidery to weaving, students will learn variety of fiber art techniques to create one of a kind projects. and explore the basics of fiber arts. Class begins June 21 and runs Tuesdays from 4:30-6pm for 8 weeks. NO CLASS JULY 5. Maximum 10 students.

Important Program Information

- In person classes are held at 341 Beech St in downtown Pottstown. Transportation is not provided.
- While the program is free, each participant is required to pay a \$10 registration fee. The registration fee is non-refundable. (If this fee is a financial hardship, please contact us.)
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis. There are a limited number of spaces available. All applications must be received by May 31, 2022. You will be notified after that date if your child has been accepted.
- While preference will be given to students who qualify for free or reduced lunch, all students are encouraged to apply. Students who have already attended an Academy class before may apply, but preference will be given to those students who are new to the program.
- If after determining who is new to the program and who applied first, there are still more applicants than available spaces, the short paragraphs written by the student and by the parent will be used to determine who will be accepted into the program.
- You will be notified if you have been accepted into this program. **If you provide an email address, we will use that address to contact you about your application.** Please be sure to check your account regularly.
- Applicants must completely fill out the attached application form. We require a separate application form for each student who is applying.

- Every applicant must write (by themselves, in their own handwriting) why they want to participate in this program. The applicant's parent or guardian must also write why they would like their child to be attend this program.
- It is very important that the student write their section themselves. If an application is missing a student paragraph, or if a parent writes that section for their child, the application will not be accepted.
- Attendance in this program is also important. Students cannot miss more than two days of class or they will be dropped from the program. Students who are dropped will not be eligible to participate in any free programs at ArtFusion 19464 for one calendar year.
- Students may not apply for and attend more than one free program during a session. (For example: if a student applies for Clay Academy, they are not eligible to attend Art Academy in the same session.) Please check the appropriate box on the application indicating the program you are applying for.
- Completed applications must be returned to ArtFusion 19464. Please do not send them to your child's school. Applications can be dropped off at our Beech St. location, scanned and emailed to info@artfusion19464.org, or mailed to the address below:
